

ALBANY PORT DISTRICT COMMISSION MINUTES OF THE GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE MEETING NOVEMBER 17, 2021

Commissioner Steffens called the meeting to order. In attendance were Commissioners Cinquanti, Coffey and Abriel. Also present were CEO Hendrick, General Counsel Jordan, CCO Daly, CFO Stuto, DSI Skubon, Maritime Business Development Manager Vasil, Director of Security Williams, Deputy Director of Security Teller and Administrative Assistant DiLillo.

Commissioner Steffens introduced the minutes of the March 24, 2021 meeting. No changes were made to the minutes. Commissioner Steffens called for a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Commissioner Coffey, seconded by Commissioner Cinquanti and passed unanimously.

REVIEW OF COMMITTEE CHARTER

Commissioner Steffens presented the Governance Committee Charter. Counsel Jordan informed the Committee that management recommends no changes to the Governance Committee Charter. The Committee concurred with management's recommendation.

Counsel Jordan mentioned to the Board that within the next few weeks he will be emailing the Board members the Evaluations of the Board's Performance and the Conflict of Interest Declarations to the Board and staff for review and completion.
